AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF WHITE SPRINGS, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR A TEXT AMENDMENT TO THE TOWN OF WHITE SPRINGS COMPREHENSIVE PLAN, AS AMENDED, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 163.3177, FLORIDA STATUTES, BY AMENDING TRANSPORTATION ELEMENT POLICY II.1.1, CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS ELEMENT POLICY VIII.2.1 AND ADDITION OF A FUTURE TRANSPORTATION MAP TO BE INCLUDED INTO THE TOWN OF WHITE SPRINGS, FLORIDA COMPREHENSIVE PLAN UNDER THE AMENDMENT PROCEDURES ESTABLISHED IN SECTIONS 163.3161 THROUGH 163.3248, FLORIDA STATUTES, AS AMENDED; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE
